

Cofca Cough syrup is a natural product and contains an active ingredient, which is herbal extract. With the following information, we wish to explain to you how this preparation helps to combat your repiratory tract illness-effectively and gently.

Ivy Leaf Extract: For hundreds of years, many people have trusted in the effective healing power of medicinal ivy for cough and the treatment of inflammatory illnesses of the respiratory tract. Cofca Cough Syrup: An effective solution which liquefies mucus, relaxes convulsive cough and calms coughing. Composition:

Active Ingredients: Each 5ml solution contains 35mg of dried ivy leaf extract.

Indications: acute catarrh (inflammation) of the respiratory tract accompanied by coughing; symptomatic treatment of chronic inflammatory bronchial diseases.

Contraindications: in the event of fructose intolerance, treatment should be carried out only after consultation with a doctor. Pregnancy and breast-feeding: Medicine should generally be taken during pregnancy and breast-feeding only after having previously consulted a doctor.

Side effects: in rare cases, Cofca Cough Syrup may have gentle laxative effect.

Interactions with other drugs:

Adverse effects have not become known with the simultaneous ingestion of Cofca Cough Syrup and other medicines. This preparation can therefore be combined safely with other medicines, such as antibiotics for example.

Dosage:	
Infants & children below 6 years of age	2.5ml, 3 Times Daily
Children 6 to 12 years of age	5ml, 3 Times Daily
Children above 12 years and adults	5ml-7.5ml, 3 Times Daily

Shake the bottle well each time before use!

Duration of Use: duration of treatment depends on the type and severity of the clinical picture: however, treatment should last for at least one week even in minor inflammations of the respiratory tract. Treatment with Cofca Cough Syrup should be maintained for 2-3 days after symptoms have subsided, in order to ensure lasting success of therapy. In the event of persistent complaints or the appearance of shortness of breath, fever as well as purulent or bloody expectoration, a doctor should be consulted immediately.

Storage instruction and shelf life: Store below 25°C. Cofca Cough Syrup should not be used after the expiry date.

Cofca Cough Solution for the whole family: Cofca Cough Syrup is free from sugar. Therefore, it is suitable for diabetics. It is also an effective medicine for children and adults for fighting against the complaints of bronchial illnesses.
